Kamala Harris: The Vice President - The White House (The Truths We Hold)

I would like to quote some of Harris' remarkable information about American society: Blacks have a higher mortality rate than whites in eight of the top 10 causes of death in the United States.

The mortality rate for black babies from birth to toddler/infant is twice that of white babies. That's more than it was in the 1850s when slavery was legal...

Black women are three times more likely to die from pregnancy-related complications than white women.

Although blacks are twice as likely to have kidney failure as whites, they are 3.5 times less likely to benefit from dialysis machines than whites.

I should open the parenthesis: Harris also discusses what the opioid pill, about which I wrote in my book "The Black Box", caused in the USA, which killed 350,000 Americans in twenty years.

Ah, Harris, the drug lobbies in our country do not want such issues to come to the fore! Anyway, It's not just healthcare...

Harris' area of expertise is law. He also gave examples here.

THE INEQUALITY DIMENSIONThe average bail fee in the USA is ten thousand dollars. The income inequality in America, which has an average income of \$45,000, is so great that nine out of ten people detained cannot pay bail to get out.

For the same punishment, black men pay 35% more in bail than white men.Inmates awaiting trial account for 95 percent of the prison population in the United States.

Black men are six times more likely than whites to be imprisoned, and when convicted, black men receive approximately 20% longer sentences than whites. Black drivers are 85% more likely to be pulled over to the side of the road than whites, and black drivers are three times more likely to have their cars searched than whites.

A roof over their heads cannot meet basic needs such as food at the table, childcare, health services, transportation, and mobile phones for 43 percent of the US population.
